

**Parking address when using GPS:** 410 Minto street, Sherbrooke, Qc., J1H 0E9

**Boarding and ticket office:** At Marché de la Gare, 720 Minto street, Sherbrooke, J1H 0E9

**Head office and postal address:** 1175, King Ouest, Sherbrooke, Qc., J1H 1S6

**Train outing lasting about 3 h 30 with gastronomical meal served aboard. Departure from Sherbrooke with route extending to Eastman and a panoramic stop on the return trip at Merry Point in Magog.**

**Municipal parking lot “de la Cigarerie”, behind the APCHQ building**

Rate: \$1/hour, 1<sup>st</sup> hour free.

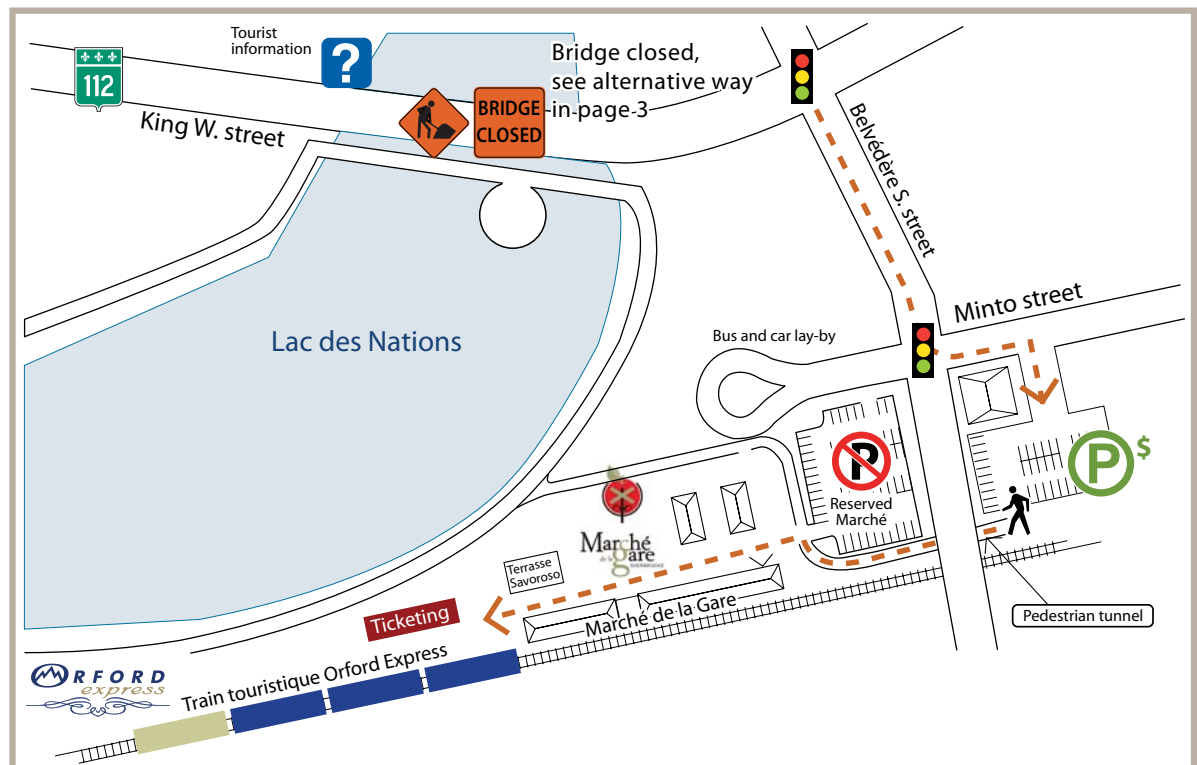
**The time it takes for the train outing is an approximate estimate. You should plan for a few extra minutes to park,** in case there is a brief hitch. (Suggested overall time is 5 hours).

You should always park in the lot near the APCHQ building.

There are 3 time-stamping ticket machines; if one of them doesn't function, please move on to the next one to make your payment.

Use the pedestrian tunnel (near the fence) under rue Belvédère, and this will lead you, in the direction of the lake, to Marché de la Gare, next to which are the train and ticket outlets.

\*Never use the parking lot near the train station. It has a 3-hour limit after which you might have to pay a fine.



### Bus and car lay-by

There is also a bus and car lay-by available. On rue Belvédère, turn right on rue Minto. You should then park in the lot behind the APCHQ building.

\* Never use the parking lot near the train station. It has a 3-hour limit after which you might have to pay a fine.

Wheelchairs are available on request. Please enquire at the ticket office in the Caboose (red train).

### Billetterie

You should pick up your tickets at the Caboose, the red coach next to the train, 30 minutes before you climb aboard. You should mention the name of the reservation and give the confirmation number. Those who hold gift certificates should proceed in the same way.

There are souvenirs on sale in the Caboose during day time business hours.

### Embarquement

It is preferable for you to present yourself some 30 minutes before the scheduled train departure. We cannot wait for anyone who is late and there are no reimbursements for late arrivals.

For the "Soupers à la Brunante" (dinner at dusk) and the "P'tits Plaisirs Gourmands" (life's small gourmet pleasures), two **different** platters selected by the chef are served per table. **So, if there are 2 of you, each of you will have a different offering according to the menu in force for your particular outing. Menus are changed each week for the Soupers à la Brunante and the P'tits Plaisirs Gourmands. The third offering, the Brunch, presents a fixed, 3-course menu which is served at the tables.

## Alternative route - via boulevard Portland

In the event that there is road work going on in the rue King Ouest sector, the city of Sherbrooke will close certain traffic arteries. To limit the impact on automobile circulation during the period of the work, please note the suggested road itinerary to help avoid delays.

**Exit 140** of autoroute **10 / 55**; then take **autoroute 410 E** in the direction of Sherbrooke. Take **exit 2** toward Boulevard Portland. At the stop, turn left on Boulevard Industriel. At the traffic light, turn left onto Boulevard Portland. Once on Portland, stay in the right lane until you reach a fork, and continue stay in the right lane which eventually becomes Belvédère Nord. Cross over the Hubert-C. Cabana bridge, then, shortly after, rue King where you will go into the left lane. At the traffic light, turn left on **Minto** and park at the municipal lot (la Cigarerie (\$)) behind the APCHQ building.

Please count on 20 to 30 additional minutes to reach the train itself.

## Alternative route, via autoroute 610

In the event that there is road work going on in the rue King Ouest sector, the city of Sherbrooke will close certain traffic arteries. To limit the impact on automobile circulation during the period of the work, please note the suggested road itinerary to help avoid delays.

**Exit 143** of autoroute **10 / 55**; then take **autoroute 610 E**. Take **exit 3** for rue St-François in the direction of Sherbrooke. Turn left on **Boulevard Saint-François nord** and continue to drive on this artery. Turn right on rue **King Ouest** and stay in the left lane. At the traffic light, turn left on **Belvédère Sud** and again stay in the left lane. At the traffic light, turn left on **Minto** and park at the municipal lot (la Cigarière (\$)) behind the APCHQ building.

Please count on 20 to 30 additional minutes to reach the train itself.
